

The Presidential Preference Primary is unique. The timelines and laws governing this election differ from other primary and general elections.

The following are some notable differences.

Presidential Preference Primary

- 1 No three-day grace period for advance mail ballots. Ballots must be received by Election Day.
- Advance mail ballot application must be submitted no later than February 20, 2024
- Voter registration deadline is 31 days prior to Election Day. (February 20, 2024)
- County Board of Canvassers must meet no later than eight days after Election Day.
- 5 State Board of Canvassers shall meet before April 12, 2024.

Primary and General Elections

- 1 Advance mail ballots must be postmarked by Election Day and received the Friday following Election Day.
- Advance mail ballot applications must be submitted the Tuesday prior to Election Day.
- Yoter registration deadline is 21 days prior to Election Day.
- County Board of Canvassers must meet 6-13 days following Election Day.
- 5 State Board of Canvassers shall meet no later than the 1st of the month following the election.
