



PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY

VS.

PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS



The Presidential Preference Primary is unique. The timelines and laws governing this election differ from other primary and general elections.

The following are some notable differences.

Presidential Preference Primary

- 1** No three-day grace period for advance mail ballots. Ballots must be received by Election Day.
- 2** Advance mail ballot application must be submitted no later than February 20, 2024
- 3** Voter registration deadline is 31 days prior to Election Day. (February 20, 2024)
- 4** County Board of Canvassers must meet no later than eight days after Election Day.
- 5** State Board of Canvassers shall meet before April 12, 2024.

Primary and General Elections

- 1** Advance mail ballots must be postmarked by Election Day and received the Friday following Election Day.
- 2** Advance mail ballot applications must be submitted the Tuesday prior to Election Day.
- 3** Voter registration deadline is 21 days prior to Election Day.
- 4** County Board of Canvassers must meet 6-13 days following Election Day.
- 5** State Board of Canvassers shall meet no later than the 1st of the month following the election.
