
Notice

It has come to the Commission's attention that the **Raj Goyle for State Representative** campaign has published a political advertisement without the attributions required by K.S.A. 25-4156 and K.A.R. 19-20-4. Specifically, an advertisement in a newspaper or other periodical which expressly advocates the nomination, election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for state or local office must have the word "advertisement" at the end, followed by the name of the campaign **and** the name of the chairperson or treasurer or the name of the individual who is responsible.

All future advertisements must be followed by the word "advertisement", the name of your campaign, and the name of your treasurer.

Although the advertisement as published is a violation of K.S.A. 25-4156 and K.A.R. 19-20-4, is subject to a civil fine of up to \$5,000 and is a class C misdemeanor, the Commission has decided not to take action on this first violation. Please note that any future violations would be subject to the above-mentioned penalties.
